Listed are the volunteers who generously donated their time for the numbers of hours indicated. Pins are given for the first 100 hours volunteered. Bars are then awarded for 500 hours volunteered and every 500 hours thereafter. In the past, hours awards were presented during the December luncheon. Since there will be no December meeting this year, hours for 2010-2011 will be added to those for 2011-2012. Hours awards will then be presented at the September luncheon in 2012.
